

Cycloset[®]
(bromocriptine)

- Dopamine agonist
- Mechanism of action unknown
- Add to diet/exercise in type 2

Dosing:
Take with food within 2 hrs of waking
Start with 0.8 mg once daily
Titrate to 1.6-4.8 mg once daily

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Monitor:

- BP- may potentiate BP meds
- psychotic disorders may worsen
- Renal/ hepatic disease

Drug to drug interactions:

- Protein bound drugs: e.g. Sulfa, chloramphenical, probenecid
- CYP3A4 Inhibitors/Inducers e.g. HIV protease inhibitors

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Adverse Reactions:

- GI upset
- Fatigue
- Dizziness
- Headache
- Hypotension
- Syncope
- Hypoglycemia
